## 2003-2023 Video and Film Editor – UK, NZ and worldwide

For 20 years, my primary career was in post production. I cut more than 1000 videos, films and TV episodes. I was client-facing, constantly receiving feedback, on teams of 1 to 30 editors. I was a Senior Lead Editor and Edit Producer, managing other editors and workflows. This demanded extreme focus, efficiency and organisation. I never missed a broadcast deadline.

I was highly skilled in Avid Media Composer, Adobe Premiere, After Effects, Davinci Resolve. I also specialised in 2D compositing, motion graphics, and media authoring.

I took calls on the internal staff IT support desk, providing remote assistance for Windows hardware, and off-the-shelf and bespoke software systems. This was customer-facing, shift-based, and required efficient research and creative problem-solving skills.

I managed all hardware and software systems, in both office and post production environments at this boutique Soho production company. I handled large quantities of rushes data, including ingest, backup, conversion, and authoring of all digital formats.

We specialised in code injection for WMV files which allowed our servers to track videos viewed and shared online, providing valuable 'viral' metrics for advertisers.

I was in charge of video post production, hosting and streaming for the UK's busiest music website, Drum & Bass Arena. (This was before YouTube even existed.)

I managed our UK-based edit suites and edited all video content for our streaming site, coded in HTML and ASP. I also ran AV systems, cameras, vision mixers, and Windows Media encoders for live ISDN webcasts at events across the UK, Europe and USA.
